

Application: PowerPoint – Useful Shortcut and Function keys

Tip: Always remember to check that the function keys have not been overridden by any in-house customisations.

Key	Action
F1	Activates the Help task pane
Ctrl+ F1	Activates or hides the Ribbon
F2	Selects the text box the cursor is positioned in
F5	Runs the current presentation
F4	Repeats last command or action (if possible)
Shift+F4	Repeats the last find action
Ctrl+F6	Switches between current workbook and last viewed open workbook
F7	Activates the Spell Check Task Pane
Shift+F9	Toggles the display of gridlines
Alt+F9	Toggles the display of the guides
Shift+Alt+F9	Toggles the display of the ruler
Shift+F10	Displays shortcut menu for selected item
Ctrl+A	Selects all objects on current slide or all text in text box
Ctrl+D	Duplicates slide selected in the slide thumbnail panel or duplicates a selected object on a slide. Note: when you reposition the object Ctrl+D will duplicate the slide in a relative position
Ctrl+K	Displays the hyperlink dialog box in a text box

Tip: Not all function keys are included as some have other more commonly used shortcut keys e.g. **Ctrl+B (bold)**

Key	Action
Ctrl+M	Inserts a New slide
Ctrl+Shift+C	Copies formatting attribute from selected object. Select another object. Press Ctrl+Shift+V to paste formatting
Ctrl+Shift+G	Groups currently selected objects
Ctrl+Shift+H	Ungroups currently selected objects
Ctrl+Spacebar	Removes manual character formatting and resets to default
Ctrl+]]	Increases font size to next size in drop-down list
Ctrl+[[Decreases font size to next size in drop-down list
Ctrl+=	Toggles subscript on selected text
Ctrl+Shift+=	Toggles superscript on selected text
Ctrl+Enter	Moves to next title or body text placeholder
Ctrl+Shift+Tab	Toggles between the slide thumbnail panel and outline panel in Normal View
Alt+Shift+↑	Moves selected paragraph up in Outline View
Alt+Shift+↓	Moves selected paragraph down in Outline View
Alt+Shift++	Expands text below a heading in Outline View
Alt+Shift+-	Collapses text below a heading in Outline View
